End of Spring Term Newsletter

Dear Parents / Carers,

Time continues to move so quickly! We draw another term to a close at 12.30pm on Friday 8th April, and move into the final few weeks of this academic year, returning on Monday 25th April at 8.50am for the summer term. During the month of May, there will be the spring bank holiday (Monday 2nd May) and Polling Day (Thursday 5th May) when the school will be closed to all pupils. The end of Ramadan and the celebration of Eid ul Fitr will possibly fall in the same week but this will be confirmed at a later date.

Statutory assessments

KS1 and KS2 SATs will be administered on our return. **KS1 SATs will run across the month of May** while **KS2 SATs** are timetabled for the **week beginning 9**th **May**. Details are as such:

Monday 9th May 2022 – English grammar, punctuation and spelling – papers 1 & 2

Tuesday 10th May 2022 – English reading

Wednesday 11th May 2022 – Mathematics – papers 1 & 2

Thursday 12th May 2022 – Mathematics – paper 3

Teacher assessments of individual writing skills will then be submitted later in the term (June 2022). Yr.1 pupils will complete the Phonics Screening Check during the week beginning Monday 6th June and Yr.4 will then complete the Multiplication Tables Check within three weeks of the same date.

Swimming



Swimming sessions will focus on Yr.2 at Ladywood Leisure Centre on a Monday afternoon for Yr.2A (beginning April 25th) with the parallel class, Yr.2B, on a Friday morning (beginning April 29th). Teaching swimming and water safety is a requirement of the national curriculum. As such, all children are expected to participate each week and should arrive in school with their swimming kit and a towel. The swim wear for girls is a standard swimming costume, or

burkini. Alternatively, they can wear tight leggings with a swimming costume.

The swimming kit for boys is a pair of trunks that come just above the knee (not P.E shorts).

Well-being

We have continued to support the children's well-being over the spring term and funded the rewards assembly; theatre visits; yoga and jewellery making sessions! To end the term we will also be sending out chocolate eggs for the children to enjoy over the holiday.

Educational Visits

Our educational visits have also now resumed. While they will continue to be subsidised, the spiralling costs of fuel and coach hire means we will now need to request a payment from parents to enable the visit to take place. Anyone needing support will however, be able to set up a payment plan with a member of the admin team.

Birthday Treats



Given the current financial difficulties many families are facing, we are requesting that parents do **not** bring in cakes, chocolates, sweets etc. for children's birthdays. This practice places an unnecessary burden on family budgets and is also difficult to

manage for children with allergies. Within school we have purchased certificates and stickers to mark children's birthdays and will celebrate their special day with them in class. We believe this approach is much fairer for all children and request your support in adhering to this.

Half term activities

Birmingham City Council are organising activities over the spring bank holiday for all children entitled to free school meals. Attendance at the activity clubs will also ensure children have a nutritious meal. If any parent is interested
